

SECOND GRADE ACTIVITIES SUGGESTIONS- JANUSZ KORCZAK LESSON

- Beeswax or clay modelling. Child King atop a horse with a green flag
- Making Green Flags. This can be done with paper and found sticks, but may also be a re-use, recycle activity using old t-shirts for cutting the fabric, dying with water colors or diluted acrylics and attaching to found sticks with sewing or adhesive, and the sticks are cleaned or sanded.
- Service Project. Find a local effort on behalf of needy children; example: books- each child selects a book from home to make a collection of books for a shelter or after school program in the area.
- Being Grateful. Engaging actively in tasks that are helpful to others takes the students into a living experience of Dr. Korczak's wish for children to build a more kind, just and peaceful world. Ask your students to do something that is helpful in their family or in their school.
